Those we serve are often considered the chronically homeless and many of them have emotional and/or psychological issues and/or a history of substance abuse. Case management services are available for all residents. Whether seeking further education or developing employment skills, clients within the Transitional Housing program are working toward becoming productive members of the community, developing skills that will enable them to be self-sufficient.

Private Pay Housing: House of Charity has beds available at below market rate rent for those who are employed or have a source of income (includes room, electricity, heat, water and access to the Food

4b (Code: ) (Expenses \$ 528,553. including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ ) Food Centre: Our Food Centre is located at 714 Park Ave. in downtown Minneapolis and is open every day of the year. Volunteers and staff prepare and serve hot, nutritious meals. The Food Centre offers two public meals, a breakfast that is open to women, children and men with children and a noon meal, which is open to all the general public. We generally serve about 350 people per day. We have a "no questions asked" philosophy about feeding the hungry - we serve anyone in need of a meal. We strive to create a safe and respectful environment to ensure our guests' comfort. In addition, we provide three meals a day to our clients residing in our 510 Building. The Food Centre served a total of 125,496 meals in 2016.

Day by Day is an enhanced co-occurring chemical dependency program, with mental health services, for residents and outpatients ages 18 and older. In 2016, the co-occurring treatment program served 153 individuals. The Day by Day program includes the following: chemical health assessments, group therapy, individual counseling, family counseling and mental health services. The mental health component features:
\* A comprehensive mental health assessment;
\* A curriculum built upon evidenced based practices to best address the unique needs of the clients that we serve

GRH (Group Residential Housing): House of Charity has 103 beds available. In this program, the State of Minnesota provides room and board for low income individuals who meet GRH requirements. This can be both a short-term or long-term housing option, based on client needs and eligibility. Clients' participating in the Day by Day Program and who are in need of housing are invited to complete applications for this housing option.

VA beds: The Veterans Administration contracted with House of Charity to hold beds for Veterans experiencing homelessness. At the end of 2016, 14 beds were set aside and filled.

Altogether, the Transitional Housing programs provided housing to 260 individuals in 2016, with an average length of stay 188 days for the GRH clients.

Housing First, a Scatter-Site Permanent Supportive Housing Program: House of Charity began participating in the Housing First program through Hennepin County in August 2010. Housing First is a national best practice model. It operates on the premise that housing is a basic human right and that people experiencing homelessness have a much higher chance of overcoming barriers when they have a safe, stable place to live. The program seeks to place clients in affordable

community housing and overlay supportive services.

Case Managers provide home visits once a week, providing guidance on being a good tenant and communicating with the landlord, as well as information on nutrition, cooking, budgeting and managing physical health issues and medications. Many Housing First participants are now enrolled in school or a training program so that they can secure better employment in the near future. House of Charity is working on placing people in geographic clusters to promote natural support groups of clients housed near each other.

To qualify for the program, participants must be long-term homeless or have a long-term disability. Clients receive a rent subsidy, passed through House of Charity, and supplemental nutrition supports. The result has been that previously hard-to-place clients, who often struggled to find housing and achieve self-sufficiency, are now stably housed and are able to attend school, gain employment, reunite with their families, and/or secure additional income. In 2016, Housing First served 141 clients.

We have a 3-phase system of treatment to meet the needs of clients at various points in their recovery.

Phase 1 is an intensive 5 day a week program for 10 weeks. Clients have 15 hours of group programming as well as at least 1 hour of individual counseling per week.

Phase 2 is a medium-intensity program that meets 3 days a week and focuses on additional skill building for relapse prevention and providing the ability to address the symptoms of mental health without self-medication or self-defeating behaviors.

Phase 3 is ongoing individual counseling at the pace and level needed to meet the client's needs.

Through group and individual sessions, clients learn to develop coping skills, manage relapse triggers, increase personal awareness, and build healthy relationships. Clients work with to build individual recovery plans that also include goals related to education, life skills, housing, physical health, employment and recreational activities. House of Charity staff work with clients to help them build skills for "re-entry" and connect them to a variety of community resources, including recovery groups in their area.

Day by Day is a gender-specific program where men's and women's groups are held separately to allow the clients to address their needs and issues in a gender-specific group to increase feelings of safety and support.

Since our humble beginnings serving people at a 5-seat table and accommodating overnight guests on our floor, House of Charity has grown to address the root causes of long-term instability - including chemical dependency, mental illness, and lack of opportunity to gain life skills, attain quality education and secure employment.

Building on our over 60-year history of meeting critical needs in the community, House of Charity has been working to enhance the quality of its client services, as well as expand the breadth of its programs and increase the number of clients served. Our vision is to transform lives - one person at a time. With a variety of programs in housing, treatment, health and case management, and a Food Centre that provides free meals 365 days a year, House of Charity helps some of the most vulnerable people move off the streets and toward self-sufficiency.

In 2015, House of Charity purchased the Finance and Commerce property at 615 South 7th Street, Minneapolis. The property is adjacent to the House of Charity Food Centre located at 714 Park Avenue South. The partners in this purchase include the Twin Cities Community Land Bank and Community Housing Development Corporation.

The new development project includes a five story building with a new Food Centre space, expanded Day by Day Outpatient Recovery Program, and administrative offices on the first and second floors. Floors three through five will have 55 new Permanent Supportive Housing studio apartments for long-term homeless single adults. The building will

include a large private deck on the 5th floor for the residents and off-sidewalk queueing space for Food Centre guests.
